Canteen Facilities will be operating. BBQ Style lunch and drinks will be available for purchase from the Canteen on the day.

The aim of the day is to encourage more riders onto a safe track and off areas where they may be riding illegally or more importantly riding without the necessary supervision.

RDMC has been in operation at the Long Point Road Track

for over 30 years. It has been the home track for champion riders such as Lee Hogan and Cheyne Boyd to name a few.

RDMC is a family orientated club with over 70% of memberships family riders.

The Club has regular race meetings and has practice days on most Sundays throughout the year.

RDMC has three tracks that cater for riders from as young as 5 years to 65 years!
